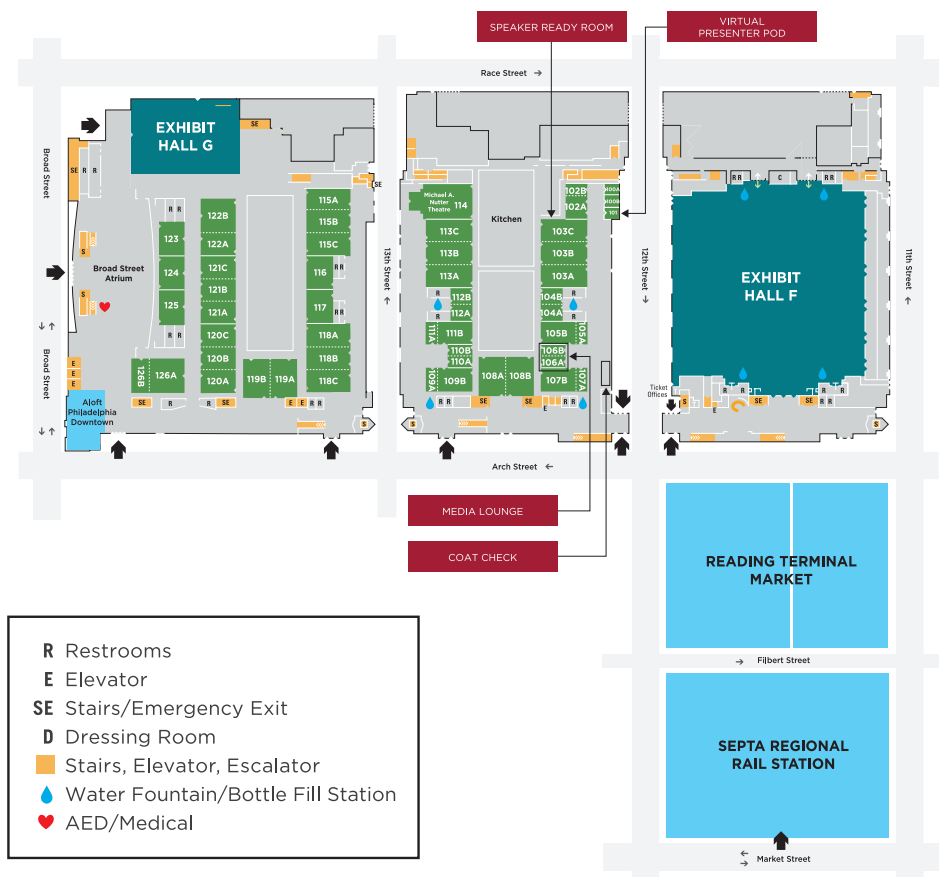

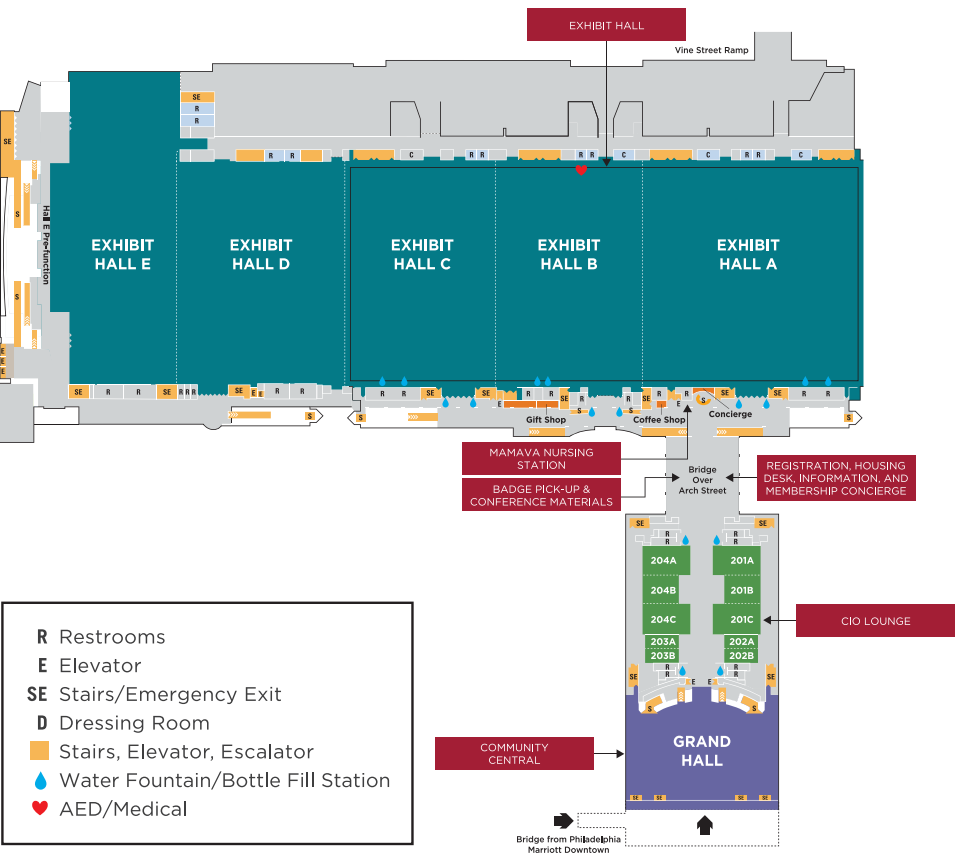

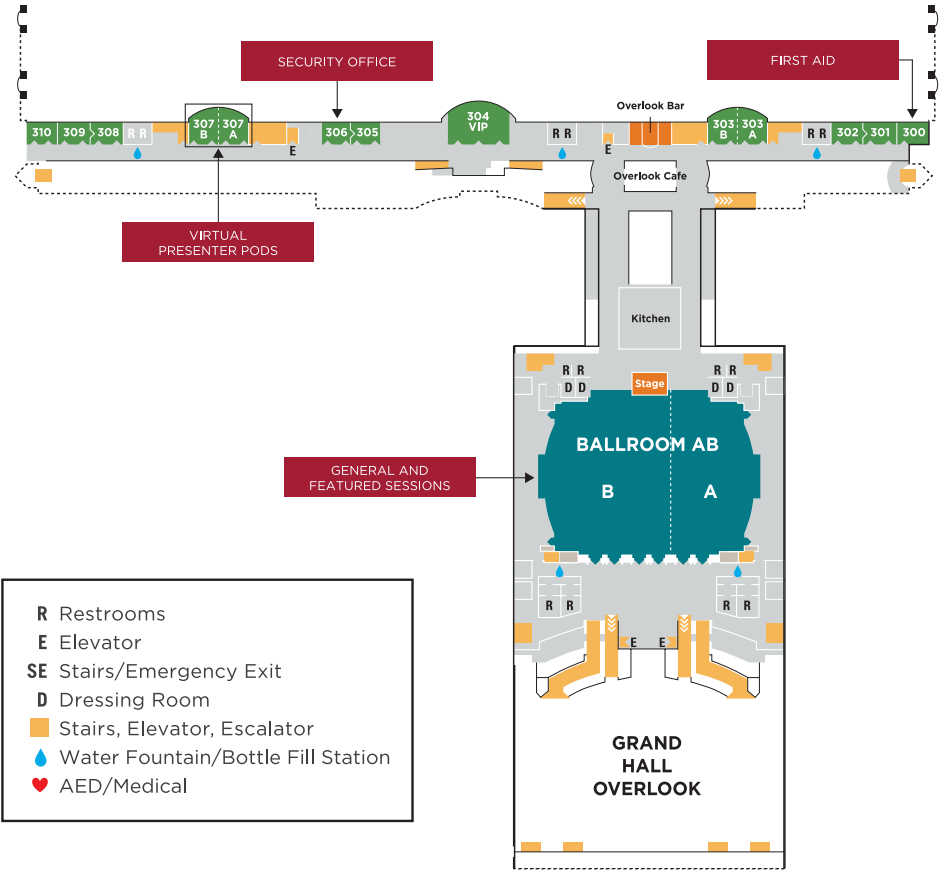

What is a braindate?

Evacuation Safety

- Remain calm and proceed in an orderly manner
- Leave the facility through the nearest exit as instructed
- Do not take time to retrieve personal property
- Do not attempt to use elevators or escalators
- Assist elderly people and people with disabilities
- Listen for instructions via the public address system
- Do not try to re-enter the building until an "all clear" message is given

Emergency Announcement Protocol

Should a potential emergency evacuation occur, the Pennsylvania Convention Center Command Staff will confirm that an evacuation is necessary before sounding the building alarm.

The alarm consists of an automatic three-way notification:

1. Audible alarm
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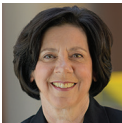
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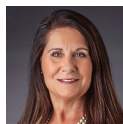
